FIXES

- **VOYAGER TRACKER**
Fixed an issue with tracked object synchronization in **nDisplay** mode.
- **VOYAGER PLUGIN**
Fixed an issue affecting the color calibration systems.

Fixed issues with the **SimulateVITCFields** media profile setting.

UPDATES

- **BACK BUFFER PIXEL FORMAT**
Updated the default back buffer pixel format for Voyager project templates.

VERSION 8.0.1 – APRIL 2026

COMPATIBILITY

Voyager 8.0.1 is not fully compatible with Voyager Trackless 8.0 due to changes in the Web API response format. For proper operation, Voyager 8.0.1 should be used with Voyager Trackless 8.0.1.

WHAT'S NEW

- **UNREAL ENGINE**

Voyager has migrated from Unreal Engine 5.3.2 to Unreal Engine 5.6.0.

- **RVS PROJECT MANAGER**

- You can now publish your Voyager projects to the XPression Project Server using the new RVS Project Manager application and then deploy the projects to each Voyager instance.
- Added a button to the UI to launch the RVS Project Manager.
- Added web server endpoints and systems for integration with the RVS Project Manager.

- **NEW BLUEPRINTS**

Added three new blueprints: OnTracklessCameraChanged, OnTrackedCameraChanged, and GetActiveCamera.

IMPROVEMENTS

- **DATALINQ PLUGIN**

Improved integration with Raiden and PIERO systems.

- **TALLY TSL UMD PLUGIN**

Added the SendTallyMessage blueprint node.

- **RVS ENGINE SERVICE**

Updated with new integrations to support the RVS Project Manager application and workflow.

- **TEMPLATE LINKS MEDIA TARGETS SELECTION**

Fixed an issue where the **Template Links Media Targets** selection dialog was unable to properly display large lists of media targets.

VERSION 7.3 – MARCH 2025

WHAT'S NEW

- **VOYAGER API PLUGIN**

Added a new endpoint for querying current **Media Profile** properties.

- **LUCID PLUGIN**

Added monitoring and notifications of **Template Links** object changes to better synchronize Lucid object data with Voyager object changes.

Added a new notification system to broadcast Voyager notifications and messages to Lucid Studio.

- **VOYAGER CORE PLUGIN**

Added a new listener system to **Template Links** to allow other systems to monitor and respond to **Template Links** object changes.

IMPROVEMENTS

- **VOYAGER API PLUGIN**

Updated the Engine Status endpoint to include current Media Profile properties.

- **LUCID PLUGIN**

All **Template Links** actors now sent to Lucid Studio, where previously, only specific sub-types such as static meshes, blueprints, etc. were sent.

FIXES

- **VOYAGER TRACKLESS PLUGIN**

Fixed an issue where a duration of zero passed to the trackless/camera/operate endpoint caused incorrect transforms to be applied to the target camera.

- **VOYAGER CORE PLUGIN**

Fixed an issue where **Template Links** actors from streamed levels were unable to access or publish media targets or functions.

Fixed an issue where **Template Links** was sometimes displaying the wrong actor name for actors from streamed levels.

- **LUCID PLUGIN**

Fixed an issue where functions of actors belonging to streamed levels weren't triggering properly when activated from Lucid Studio.

- **DATALINQ PLUGIN**

Fixed an issue where toast notifications weren't being displayed to the user after the first notification.

- **KEY PROCESSING**

Fixed an issue with the processing of the key when using non-linear compositing.

- **POTENTIAL CRASH**

Fixed an issue where the application could crash when assigning multiple **Voyager Tracker Actors** to a **Voyager Operator** actor.

- **GENLOCK**

Fixed an issue where Matrox would crash when applying **GenLock** settings with mismatched framerates.

- **VOYAGER TRACKER**

Fixed an issue with Stype distortion and aspect ratio.

- **RVS ENGINE SERVICE**

Fixed an issue where the setting for the RVS Engine Service **Switchboard Listener Only** path was not taking effect after restarting the service.

Fixed an issue where RVS Engine Service was not available when running in **Switchboard Listener Only** mode and there was no path for **Switchboard Listener** specified.

VERSION 7.2 – OCTOBER 2024

WHAT'S NEW

- **TIMECODE SUPPORT**

Timecode is now supported on both Matrox IP 2110 and Matrox 12G cards.

- **MANAGE FUNCTIONS PANEL**

Added a **Manage Functions** panel to the **Template Links** window, to select which functions to publish.

IMPROVEMENTS

- **VOYAGER DESIGNER IMPROVEMENTS**

Added support for watermarked Inputs/Outputs in both **Node** and **Editor** mode.

Different watermarks for **Editor** and **Outputs** that are less intrusive and distracting.

- **TIMECODE**

Added a new general setting for **Timecode Events** to control whether missed events have been fired or discarded on subsequent frames.

Timecode Events that could be missed and held indefinitely within the event queue during frame loss are now detected and handled.

- **SUPPORT FOR TEMPLATE LINKS**

Added support for publishing **Level** and **Actor Functions** in **Template Links**.

- **DATALINQ PLUGIN**

Added a **DataLinq MultiValue Actor** properties category button for quick direct access.

Improved **DataLinq MultiValue Actor** properties sorting.

FIXES

- **DESKTOP ICON**

Fixed an issue where the **Voyager Node** icon was created during installation, even if **Desktop Shortcuts** was not selected.

- **DATALINQ**

Fixed an issue when using multiple DataLinq Keys on the same multi-value component.

Fixed an issue when using the RSS/HTTP DataLinq source with Table Presets.

- **TEMPLATE LINKS**

Fixed an issue where an actor's display name would not match after renaming.

Fixed column sizing in the **Template Links** window.

Fixed an issue where **Template Links** object settings weren't being saved in some usage scenarios.

Fixed an issue where all published **Template Links** actors were being sent to Lucid as viable media targets, without considering the individual media target status of the actors.

- **ROSSTALK MESSAGES**

Fixed an issue where RossTalk messages containing the values "08" and "09" were not being parsed correctly.

- **LIT / UNLIT COMMANDS**

Fixed an issue where Lit / Unlit commands from Lucid were not actually showing lit / unlit materials (only works in Legacy Mode).

VERSION 7.1 – AUGUST 2024

WHAT'S NEW

- **VOYAGER NODE LICENSE**

Support for a new license to run Voyager in game mode only, with no editor user interface support.

- **VOYAGER NODE SHORTCUT**

Desktop shortcut to run Voyager in **Game** mode only (no editor), giving the user the option to select which project to load.

- **TIMECODE-BASED EVENT SCHEDULING AND EXECUTION**

Added a new Timecode-based event scheduling feature that enables the execution of events based on Timecode. Users can now schedule an event to occur at a specific time and frame.

- **TIMECODE FOR ADRIENNE LTC CARD**

Added LTC Timecode support for the Adrienne timecode card.

- **TIMECODE-BASED EVENT SCHEDULING USING ROSSTALK**

Added new Timecode-based event scheduling using RossTalk command:
(TC hh:mm:ss:ff:aa:vv)

- **RVS ENGINE SERVICE UPDATED**

The RVS Engine Service has been updated with **Game**, **Editor** and **Switchboard Listener Only** running modes.

- **VS TRACKLESS TEMPLATE UPDATED**

The VS Trackless Template has been updated, removing unnecessary Trackless Camera initialization on Begin Play and setting the default Voyager Operator prepare delay property to 10.

- **NDISPLAY CLUSTER SUPPORT**

Added nDisplay cluster support for:

- Lucid String Async Blueprint nodes
- Lucid Rotator Async Blueprint nodes
- Lucid Vector Async Blueprint nodes
- Lucid Float Async Blueprint nodes
- Unreal Functions execution

- **SEND ROSSTALK COMMANDS**

Added Blueprint nodes to send RossTalk Commands (GPI, CC, SEQI, NEXT, and Custom).

- **NDI®¹ MEDIA PLUGIN**

Added NDI Media Plugin for NDI Inputs and Output. **Audio Input**, **Timecode**, and **Genlock** are not currently supported for NDI in Voyager 7.1.

Requires the new Voyager NDI Streams license.

- **INTERNAL COMPOSITING MODE**

Added the ability to select an internal compositing mode (Auto-detect, Linear, or Non-Linear) in the Voyager Operator.

In **Non-Linear** mode, pixels in the virtual graphics that are hidden by composite objects will still generate bloom, as if they were visible. This mode is intended for use with external keyers. It could have undesired effects on the edges of internal chroma keyers.

Additional live sources that are fill-only without using chroma keying can be used in either mode, based on the nature of the main composite's keying method.

- **NEW MANAGE MEDIA TARGETS PANEL**

In the **Template Links** UI, added a new **Manage Media Targets** panel to allow selection of specific texture parameters as targets. Accessed via an **Edit** button in the **Media Target** column.

IMPROVEMENTS

- **GAME MODE KEYBOARD HOTKEY**

New keyboard hotkey: SHIFT+ESC to close Game mode.

- **TRACKLESS CAMERA SWITCH PREPARE DELAY DEFAULT VALUE**

The Voyager Operator Multi Cam Prepare Delay option is now used as the default value for the Trackless camera switch.

- **MATROX DRIVERS UPDATED**

Updated the Matrox drivers for Voyager 7.1 to Matrox DSX 10.4 SP1 (10.4.101.1334).

FIXES

- **LUCID ASYNCHRONOUS NODE EXECUTION**
Issue with executing Lucid Asynchronous nodes when running in nDisplay mode.
- **EXECUTING FUNCTIONS IN NDISPLAY MODE**
Issue with executing Unreal Functions from Lucid when running in nDisplay mode.
- **FOCUS SETTING WITH CAMERA CUTS FROM TRACKLESS**
Issue with Focus setting when performing Camera Cuts from Trackless.
- **XML DATALINQ DATASOURCES**
Issue with XML discarding Root element.
- **LUCID EXECUTING A BLUEPRINT ASYNCHRONOUS NODE**
Issue when Lucid executes a Blueprint Asynchronous node with no name.
- **PHYSICAL SET GREEN SCREEN MODEL AND COMPOSITE GARBAGE MATTES**
Issue with incorrect position with the green screen model.

Issue with Internal Keyer in Game Mode.

Issue with unshaped option using AJA fill/key.
- **COMPOSITE PLANES DISPLAYING WHITE TEXTURE**
Issue with White Texture being displayed in newly created composite planes.

Fixed an issue where using Lumen Global Illumination would cause an AV when using the Trackless prepare cut delay.

WHAT'S NEW

- **VOYAGER HAS MIGRATED FROM UNREAL ENGINE 5.2.1 TO UNREAL ENGINE 5.3.2.**

- **TEMPLATE LINKS**

Added a Template Links User Interface in **Voyager > Windows** to manage publishing of Actors, Materials, Level Sequences, and Functions to Lucid and controlling them from Lucid and Voyager's Web API.

- **VOYAGER CHARTS**

Added a Voyager Charts category for selecting actors for pie charts, column/bar charts and line charts.

- **VOYAGER CHARTS PLUGIN**

Added a new plugin to support the Voyager Charts.

- **VOYAGER TRACKLESS PLUGIN**

Added a new Multi-Actor Media Controller blueprint.

- **DATALINQ KEY PLUGIN**

Improved the smoothness of camera animations controlled from Voyager Trackless Studio.

FIXES

- **VOYAGER COMPOSITES SHADOWS VISIBLE**

Issue with shadows still being seen regardless of being excluded from other views.

Issue when manually changing the DataLinq Source or Table Name in the Editor.

KNOWN ISSUES

- **DATALINQ PLUGIN**

CSV format source data cannot be fetched due to a known issue with the XPression DataLinq Server. CSV data can be viewed, browsed, and selected, but retrieval of any specified data fields through the blueprint system will return empty data.

WHAT'S NEW

- **VOYAGER HAS MIGRATED FROM UNREAL ENGINE 5.1.1 TO UNREAL ENGINE 5.2.1**

- **INVERT FIELDS OPTION**

Added an option in the **Media Profile** video configuration section to invert fields with interlaced AJA inputs.

- **PARALLELIZE TRANSFERS**

Added an option to parallelize transfer to the Matrox outputs to improved performance (enabled by default).

- **LOCKING TO AN INPUT**

Added support for locking to an input when using an AJA card and a Custom Time Step.

WHAT'S NEW

- **SUPPORT FOR THE NEW VOYAGER 1.0 TRACKLESS STUDIO VIRTUAL STUDIO SOLUTION**

Voyager Trackless Studio can control virtual camera movements and trigger events in a Voyager project.

- **SUPPORT FOR MULTIPLE COMPOSITING LAYERS**

Added support for multiple **Compositing Layers**, each allowing multiple **Layer Inputs**, in order to support various configurations using multiple compositing actors, in either AR, VS or Trackless workflows. Using layers that each have a single plane actor offers better performance.

- **VOYAGER OPERATOR ACTOR**

Using a prepare stage configured with **Multi Cam Prepare Delay**, you can achieve clean cuts between cameras in tracked (internal or external compositing) and trackless mode.

Added support for nonzero blend time in **VoyagerOperatorActor:TracklessCamera** when in trackless mode (as long as you aren't excluding compositing planes from the camera).

Added an **Allow Occlusion with Custom Depth** option in the **Voyager Operator** asset (in **Project Settings**) to improve performance of heavy sets in internal compositing AR mode, where writing a **Custom Depth Stencil** value is required.

- **VOYAGER COMPOSITE PLANE ACTORS**

Added the option **Exclude from other views** which supports multiple tracked or trackless cameras, each only showing the composite plane and input associated with its tracker.

Added support for **UV Offset** and **Scale** on the Voyager compositing actors in trackless compositing mode.

Added support for using a **Custom Static Mesh** on **Voyager Composite Actors** (AR, VS and Trackless); using no **Custom Static Mesh** indicates the standard 16:9 Voyager plane is used.

Added **Voyager Portrait Planes** (Left and Right) assets to be used as **Custom Static Mesh** to support vertically rotated camera feeds.

- **SUPPORT FOR OBJECT TRACKING**

In the Voyager Tracker actor, you can assign a number of generic actors to tracking data feeds sharing the same origin as the camera tracker.

- **DATALINQ PLUGIN**
