Starting Zoom Rooms

1

Enable NDI Feedback

- 1a If Remote Desktop Connection is used to access the Windows machine running Zoom Rooms, ensure to select **Play on remote computer** in the **Remote audio playback** settings.
- 1b Enable the NDI feedback output (NDI Feedback) on the SSG.
- 1b In Privacy Settings, allow apps to access your camera and microphone.
- 1c Install NDI Tools from <https://ndi.video/tools/ndi-tools/>.
- 1d Start **Webcam** App from the NDI Launcher.
- 1e Select **NDI Feedback** as the source of the Webcam.

Host a Zoom Meeting

- 2a Start the Zoom Rooms app and log into your Zoom account.
- 2b Use Zoom Rooms Controller to find Nearby Zoom Rooms.
- 2c On Zoom Rooms, host a new meeting or join a meeting with transferring host. The Zoom Rooms must be as a host to be able to broadcast NDI.
- 2c On Device Settings of the meeting:
 - > Set NDI Webcam Video 1 as the Camera.
 - > Set NDI Webcam 1(NewTek NDI Audio) as the microphone.
- 2c Disable noise suppression in Zoom.

NDI Broadcasting from Zoom Rooms

Enable NDI

- 3a Log in to the Zoom Web Portal.
- 3b Navigate to Room Management > Zoom Rooms > Account Settings > Meetings.
- 3c Scroll down to **Allow Network Device Interface (NDI) Usage**.
- 3d Toggle the setting to **ON**.

4

Zoom Rooms Controller

- 4a On the Zoom Rooms Controller, click **Change View**.
- 4b Under the Live on NDI section, click **Add Output**.
- 4c Select an Active Speaker.

NDI Streaming

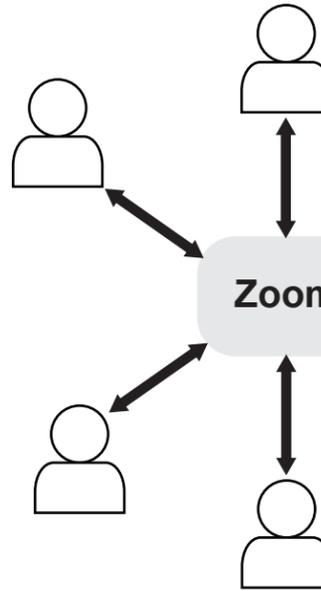
A notification informing Zoom participants that the session is streaming to NDI will be displayed in the Zoom call.
The host must tap the Zoom Rooms Controller to continue the session.

Source Configuration

Input Configuration

- 6a Open the softGear Streaming Gateway interface in DashBoard.
- 6b In the **Source Configuration** tab, create an NDI source for each participant Zoom video.



The Streaming Gateway on the DashBoard Client and the Windows computer that is hosting the Zoom Room must be on the same Local Area Network (LAN) so that the NDI streams can be transferred between them.

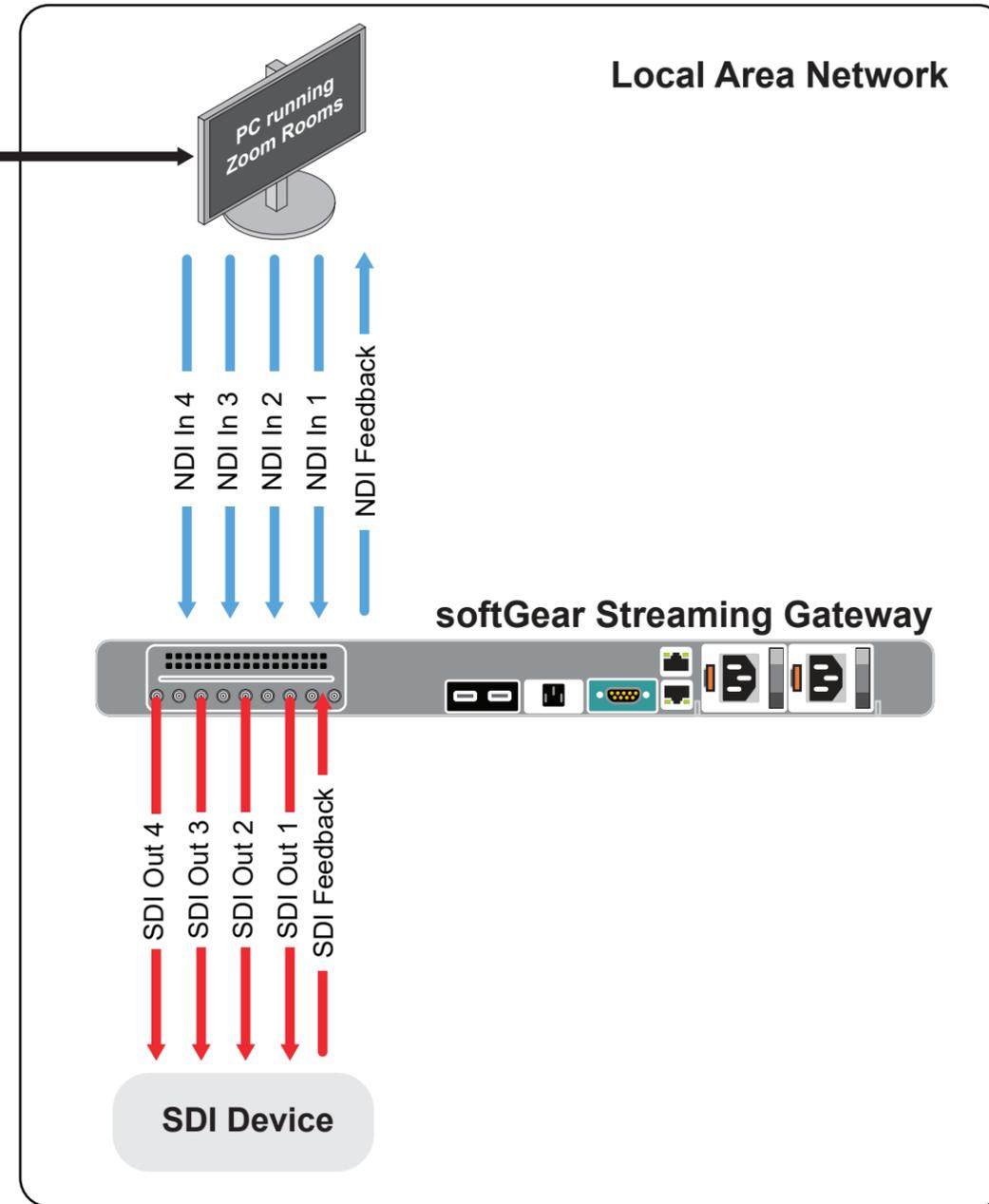
Destination Configuration

- 7a In the **Destination Configuration** tab, click **Create Destination**.
- 7b Configure the output signal by selecting an output type and editing the parameters of the output stream.

- 8b Click **Online**.
